## **New Business:**

- **a. Consider Acceptance of ODOT Agreement #32345** Tony Schneider Area Manager from Astoria, gave a review of the financial responsibilities and where the funding will be coming from for the ODOT Rail Safety Project. Schneider explained that the City will only be held responsible for the 10.27% of the \$750,000 based on bids not coming in at over 10% of the estimates and for our (City's) own utility installations, and Schneider stated that he believes this will be more than the \$811,000. After further discussion, Mayor Cole stated that based on conversation Dudley had with Schneider, he recommended voting yes on ODOT agreement #32345. Nelson made a motion to approve agreement #32345, Weaver 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve ODOT Agreement #32345. **The motion was unanimously adopted after discussion.**

- **b. Consider Approval of the IGA with the Rainier School District** Nelson moved to Approve the IGA with the Rainier School District for Library Services, Sanders 2<sup>nd</sup> to approve the IGA with the Rainier School District as presented—**motion was passed unanimously**
