- Look into having a Saturday Market and more music and festivals at the park
- Look into what it would take to replace the bathrooms at the park
- Determine the feasibility of upgrading the skate park

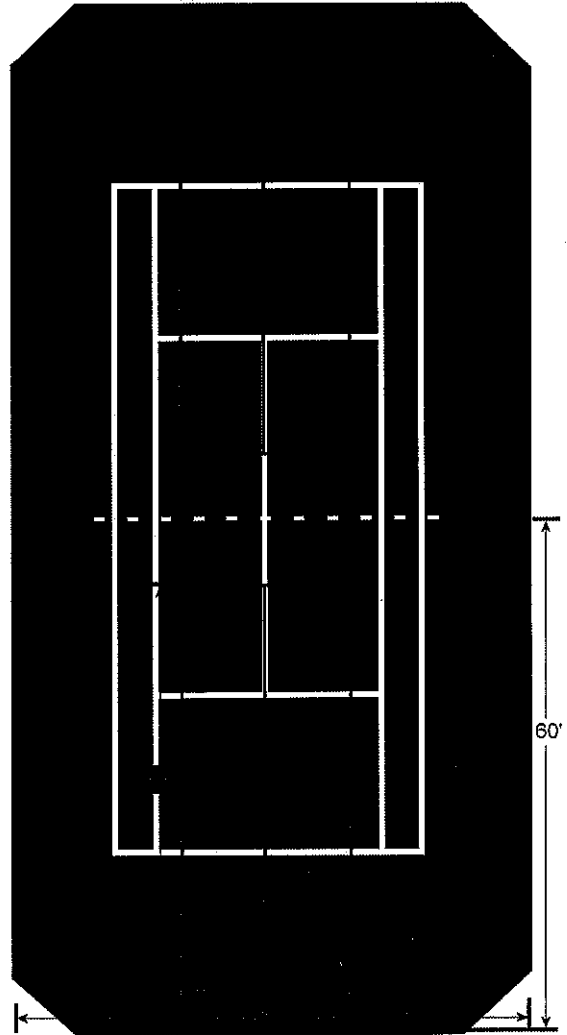
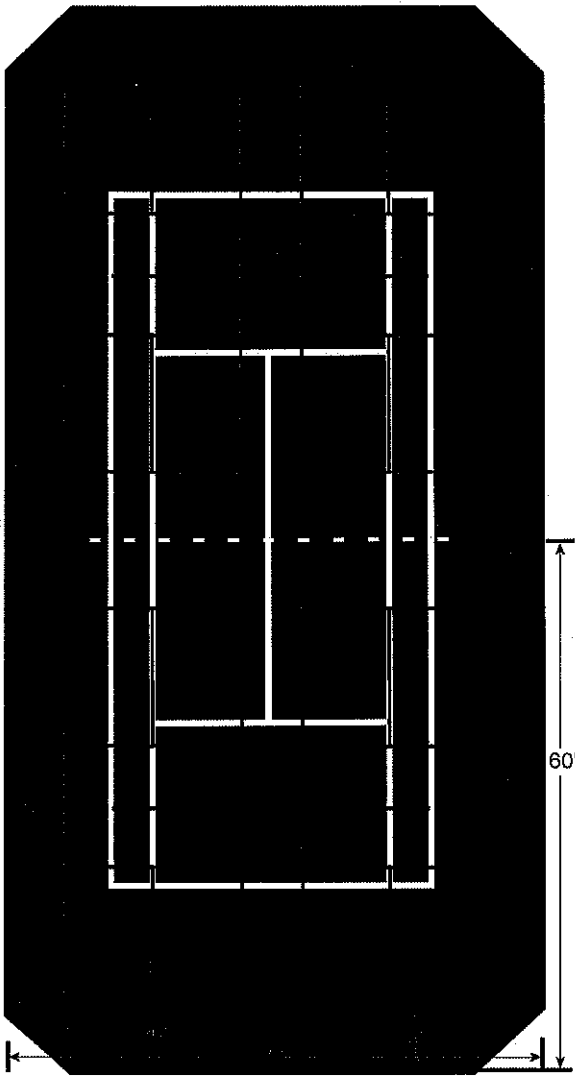
